CUSTOMS POWER OF ATTORNEY

_____ (Full name), Grantor, a (individual, partnership, corporation sole prop, or LLC) doing business as

_____ residing or having a principal place of business at

_____ hereby constitutes and appoints each of the following persons:

Versaci Group International, Inc., and/or its specifically Authorized Agents to act for the grantor named above for and in its name from this date in all Customs Districts

- to make and sign on Grantor's behalf any document required by commercial practice, law or regulation in connection with the importation of any merchandise shipped or consigned to said grantor.
- to perform any act or condition which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise to receive any merchandise deliverable to said grantor.

This authority includes

- all entries, bonds, and bills of lading electronic or otherwise.
- to authorize other Customs Brokers to act as grantor's agent;
- to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in grantor's name;
- if the grantor is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of process on behalf of the grantor;
- generally, to transact at the Customs houses in any district any and all customs business, including making, signing, and filing of protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930,
- giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done as fully as Grantor could do if present and acting,
- hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of this grant of authority,
- the forgoing power of attorney to remain in full force and effect until the _____ day of _____, _____, or until notice of revocation in writing is duly given to and received by a District Director of Customs.

Grantor hereby expressly waives the requirement that Versaci Group International, Inc.'s Customs brokerage charges be directly transmitted to it, pursuant to 19 CFR 111.36(c)(2)(i)'s waiver provision. Grantor acknowledges that Versaci Group International, Inc. and Cargo Modules LLC conduct business subject to the standard Terms and Conditions of the National Customs Brokers and Forwarders Association of America, a copy of which will be provided upon request, and agrees that those Terms and Conditions shall govern the commercial relationship between grantor and either Versaci Group International, Inc. or Cargo Modules LLC. If the donor of this power of attorney is a partnership, the said power shall expire 2 years from the date of its receipt in the office of the Port Director of Customs. If the donor of this power of attorney is a Limited Liability Company, the signatory certifies that he/she has full authority to execute this power of attorney on behalf of the grantor.
